Robin Abad, born and raised in Kalihi on the island of Oahu, discovered his passion for becoming a chef during his time at Farrington High School. Growing up in a family that frequently cooked at home and at gatherings, Robin always knew he wanted to lead, but it wasn't until he embraced cooking that his career path became clear.

He honed his skills through lifelong learning and competitions as a high school student, college student, and later as a working professional. After graduating from Kapiolani Community College with associate's degrees in culinary and pastry arts, Robin competed as part of the college's culinary teams, which served as steppingstones to his professional career.

Robin began cooking professionally as a teenager at Padovani's Restaurant and went on to work at esteemed establishments like the Four Seasons Maui, Grand Wailea Resort, and Halekulani Hotel, where he spent nine years refining his craft. His journey also included time at Alohilani Resort and stints abroad at notable locations such as La Rochelle in Tokyo, Tetsuya's in Sydney, and the Imperial Hotels in Japan.
